



## WiN Canada International Travel Award A WiN 2006 Global Conference program

WiN is a worldwide association of women working professionally in the fields of nuclear energy and applications of radiation. The goal of WiN is to contribute to objectively informing the public of nuclear and radiation.

WiN's principal objective is to emphasize and support the role women can and do have in addressing the general public's concerns about nuclear energy and the application of radiation and nuclear technology. WiN is doing this through educational programs, information exchange and arranging study visits.

### Program:

- The 14<sup>th</sup> Annual WiN-Global Meeting will showcase the nuclear industry in a unique way: by highlighting the women who are making a difference to the leadership and advancement of nuclear power and radiation technology. Approximately 300 women who work in nuclear industries (power, medical, research) from around the world will convene in Kitchener/Waterloo for three days of plenaries, reports, workshops and networking activities.
- The WiN International Travel Award is for those women who may not be able to participate due to financial constraints.

### Requirements:

As an applicant, you must agree to:

1. Take full responsibility for managing your own requirements to enter Canada should Temporary Resident Visa be required. (see [Canadian Visa Requirements](#))
2. Submit a letter of endorsement from their employer and endorsement from your WiN-Global Board member. ([WiN-Global Country/Region Representatives](#)) If no WiN-Global board member for your country, please contact Barbara Goetz (details below) who will make arrangements through WiN-Global.
3. Cover your own costs for any cultural tours they wish to attend.
4. Either join a WiN chapter in your own region or initiate one if one does not exist.
5. Submit expense report along with invoices by the end of the conference. Expenses will be reimbursed within two weeks after the conference.

### Application Procedure:

1. Compile all necessary documentation; attach supporting documents to the application.
2. Forward the full application package to the mail address provided below or fax.
3. Within 10 days of receipt of your package, the WiN 2006 Global meeting organizers will mail you a confirmation and an official letter of invitation which is required for a Temporary Resident Visa.
4. The WiN 2006 Global meeting organizers will notify all applicants in writing on the success of their application by March 10, 2006.
