About nuclear in FRANCE



- **Number of reactors in service: 58, 63.1 GWe installed**
- **Percent of electricity from nuclear: 87 % (EDF), 78% (France)**
- **Reactor types:**
 - PWR (Pressurized Water Reactor)
- **Future of nuclear power in FRANCE**
 - New nuclear build underway:
 - EPR (European Pressurized Reactor) at Flamanville.
 - ITER (International Thermonuclear experimental reactor) at Cadarache.
 - New nuclear build policy:
 - The draft Act on the management of radiocative material and waste further to the outcomes of the “Bataille Act” was voted on 12 April 2006 at the French National Assembly.
 - Public debates ended for EPR and ITER.

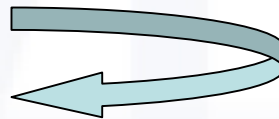
About our achievement
